LOOKING AT ME LOOKING AT YOU, Ali Tahayori's first solo exhibition at THIS IS NO FANTASY, coincides with the gallery's presentation of his work at Unseen Photo Fair Amsterdam.

The exhibition reflects the interdisciplinary nature of Tahayori's practice, featuring mirror works, photographic-based mirror pieces and multimedia installation.

LOOKING AT ME LOOKING AT YOU centres around the mechanics of looking. Blurring the boundaries between photography, drawing and sculpture, each medium informs and complements the others, and combine to reflect the complexity of human identity.


Tahayori's practice aims to provide a queer perspective on portraiture, and in queering the gaze, it gives the portrait a right of reply, an agency in looking back at the viewer. Complicating the ideas of ownership and agency, the works pose the question: Who owns the image, who looks at it and who is at the centre of the observer's gaze.

BIO

ALI TAHAYORI's interdisciplinary practice ranges from conceptual photography to the moving image, and installation. Tahayori uses archival materials, narrative fragments and performative modalities to explore themes of identity, home, and belonging. Combining fractured mirrors with text and imagery, his works draw on ancient Iranian philosophies about light and mirrors to create kaleidoscopic experiences; moments of both revelation and concealment hint at the conflicted nature of his identity. Translating the traditional Iranian craft of Aine-Kari (mirror-works) into a contemporary visual vocabulary, his practice combines a discourse about diaspora and displacement with an exploration of queerness – in both cases, poignantly testifying to his experience of being othered.


Born in Shiraz, Iran, Tahayori currently lives and works in Sydney, Australia (Gadigal country). Raised in the oppressively homophobic climate of 1980s Iran, Tahayori assumed the identity of an outsider, further compounded by his migration to Australia in 2007. He holds a Doctorate in Medicine and MFA in Photomedia from National Art School. Tahayori has exhibited locally and internationally and has been a finalist and winner of several local and International art prizes.

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




ALI TAHAYORI Key To The Field, 2022 Hand-cut mirrors & plaster on vintage window frame 86 x 76 cm NFS






ALI TAHAYORI Four Elements (Fire), 2021 Hand-cut mirrors and plaster on wood 80 x 60 cm \$3,500




ALI TAHAYORI Four Elements (Air), 2021 Hand-cut mirrors and plaster on wood 80 x 60 cm \$3,500



ALI TAHAYORI Four Elements (Earth), 2021 Hand-cut mirrors and plaster on wood 80 x 60 cm \$3,500




ALI TAHAYORI Four Elements (Water), 2021 Hand-cut mirrors and plaster on wood 80 x 60 cm \$3,500











